Studio's Residency Program is an excellent way to bring art into your school. The Residency Program serves grades pre-k through 12th and introduces students to a variety of visual arts media and techniques.

STUDIO's artists plan collaboratively with teachers to make meaning-ful curriculum links and support the creative, intellectual, and emotional growth of all students. STUDIO's artists provide students with alternative entry points for learning. Through engagements in a multi-step process, students will be able to problem-solve by demonstrating key thinking skills, apply specific knowledge, and share their understandings in highly visible and concrete ways. STUDIO's artists also support students' language development by introducing key vocabulary, and encouraging students to explain their process while expressing opinions grounded in evidence.

The Residency Program professional development workshop helps teachers understand how visual arts instruction can help support their learning goals for their students. The workshop also helps support teachers in bringing the language, concepts, and techniques of visual arts into their classrooms.



Celebrate Your Students' Success

14-week residencies culminate in an exhibition of student work. Parents and the school community are invited to join in celebrating students' creativity. The learning made visible in the displays also helps support schools during the Quality Review.
