1. Brief By-Laws Overview & New Meeting Start Time: We've designated Maria Heredia as the Time Keeper this year. - 3. **Dismissal**: The yard gate does not open until all classes are outside. Both Teresa and Annie are stationed at the gate during dismissal and they oversee anyone leaving the yard. All teachers have a list of who picks up each child in their classes. Kids will not leave until telling and high-fiving their teacher when they spot the grown-up picking them up. The teacher will make eye contact with the grown-up who is inside the yard (not outside the gates) before the child is dismissed to them. Dismissal procedure will be reinforced in Teresa's communications to parents, will be reinforced by teachers to students, and will be included in teacher's sub plans for sub-teacher dismissals.
