- Why do we not have ICT (39 is also small)
- SETSS and ICT are considered same on the LRE scale
- 2 classes per grade, ICT group will always be together, gen ed students would also be limited (in case of conflicts)
- If we don't have enough ICT IEPs, we would have to either change student IEPs to ICT to pay for teacher which does not necessarily based on students' specific needs.
- we have 19 setss in whole school, takes 12-13 per grade to pay for an ICT class
- ICT belongs to D15, children can be placed here who we don't know
- Hard to find Sped Teachers, we are going to have to form ICT class part time with the 5 Sped teachers because no additional funding is being provided
- Teacher training enrollment is declining
- ICT is not a cure-all, a strong SETSS program can be comparable
