- 1) Committee Reports: Kim Leveille is PS118's representative at the D15 Equity Congress that we hosted on May 23<sup>rd</sup> and it was a great success! SETSS teachers don't have the opportunity to plan as in depth as a second teacher in ICT. There will be a combination of ICT and SETSS throughout the school. We need to have the IEP mandates in order to have ICT, but we cannot change any students' IEP without parental permission.
